

Proof of Labor on the "Blue Bird, Boodle" & Addenda claims.

Before me, the undersigned, personally appeared Douglas Caples who being duly sworn says that at least Three hundred (\$300) dollars worth of labor and improvements were performed and made upon the Blue Bird, Boodle and Addenda quartz mining claims, said expenditures and labor being for the development of the three claims jointly consisting of twenty eight feet of tunnel on Blue Bird claim and prospecting and stripping ledge on Addenda claim and expense of supplies, building and improving trails, said labor and improvements being performed during year 1898.

Also (\$600) worth of labor and improvements performed on Blue Jacket and Kickapoo quartz mining claims, said expenditures and improvements being for the development of the said two claims jointly, consisting of forty feet of tunnel and fifty feet of shaft on Blue Jacket claim, and stripping and facing ledge on Kickapoo claim on Blue Bird Creek during the year 1898. That all of said quartz mining claims are situated in the Bald Mountain Mining District Kamiah County State of Washington and recorded at Silverton County seat of said County. That all of said labor was performed during the year ending December 1898. Such expenditures were at the expense of J. P. White, E. M. Cox, G. E. Brown and Caples and E. L. Conby and L. M. Hadden for the purpose of maintaining and holding said claim.
