

Mortgage

O. W. Bailey et ux to the Oregon Mortgage Company Limited

This Indenture made this first day of January 1887 between O. W. Bailey and Oba M. Bailey his wife of the County of Yamhill and Territory of Washington hereinafter called the Mortgagors; and the Oregon Mortgage Company Limited a Corporation duly incorporated under the laws of Great Britain and Ireland and having its registered office and principal place of business in Edinburgh Scotland hereinafter called the Mortgagee.

Witnesseth that the said Mortgagors for and in consideration of the sum of Five hundred Dollars United States Gold coin to them in hand paid the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have granted bargained sold and conveyed and by these presents do they Grant Bargain Sell and convey unto the said Mortgagee its successors legal Representatives and assigns these certain premises situated in the County of Yamhill and Territory of Washington and described as follows to wit:

The West half of the South West Quarter of Section Eighteen in Township one North of range five East of the Willamette Meridian containing eighty Acres.

Together with all and singular the tenements hereditaments and appurtenances thereto belonging or in anywise appertaining to have and to hold the same together with the tenements hereditaments and appurtenances thereto belonging or in anywise appertaining unto the said Mortgagee its successors legal Representatives and assigns forever.
