

Claim of Water Right by Geo M. Barry.

Where is hereby given, That I the undersigned
 Claim the water now lying, being or flowing
 in a certain Creek known as Rock Creek a
 tributary of Little White Salmon, in Stannish
 County, Washington, to the extent of one cubic
 foot of water per second of time and that I
 intend to use said water for the purpose of
 irrigating, taking or diverting said water at
 a point about 500 feet north of my West line
 of my homestead in Section 10 T³ S³ R⁹ East
 of Range 9 East of the Willamette Meridian
 said water to be carried by ditch or flume
 or both running in a Northwesterly direction
 to my land now in cultivation
