 Whereas, Kinzey Marr of Stannan County Washington Territory has deposited in the General Land Office of the United States a Certificate of the Register of the Land Office at Vancouver whereby it appears that Full Payment has been made by the said Kinzey Marr according to the provisions of the act of Congress of the 27th of April 1820, entitled "An act making further provision for the sale of the public lands" for the North East Quarter of the South West Quarter of Section Thirty four in Township Two North of Range Six East in the District of Lands Subject to sale at Vancouver Washington Territory. Containing forty Acres according to the Official Plat of the said Lands, returned, to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General, which said Tract has been purchased by the said Kinzey Marr.

Now Know ye, That the United States of America in Consideration of the premises and, in conformity with the several acts of Congress in such laws made and provided Have given and granted and by these presents Do Give and Grant unto the said Kinzey Marr and to his heirs, the said Tract above described To Have and to Hold the same together with all the rights, privileges, immunities and appurtenances, of whatever nature thereunto belonging unto the said Kinzey Marr and to his heirs and assigns forever.

In Testimony whereof I Andrew Johnson President of the United States of America have caused this letter to be made Patent, and the Seal of the General Land Office to be hereunto affixed.
