Witnesseth that the said parties of the first part for and in consideration of the sum of Thirty five hundred Dollars gold coin of the United States of America to them in hand paid the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged do by these presents grant bargain sell convey and confirm unto the said party of the second part its Successors and assigns forever all the certain lots or parcels of land situate lying and being in the Counties of Clark and Kanawha Territory of Washington and bounded and particularly described as follows to wit

All those two certain tracts or pieces of land with the messuages or tenements thereon erected situate and described as follows.

One of them being in the County of Clark and Territory of Washington aforesaid and being lots One (1) Two (2) Three (3) and four (4) of section one (1) and the North East Quarter of the North East Quarter of section twelve (12) in Township one (1) North of Range four (4) East of the Williamette Meridian containing one hundred and three (103) acres of land. Being the said premises which the said George H. Dorgan and Elizabeth H. Dorgan his wife by Indenture bearing date the Eleventh day of August 1876 and Recorded in the Office of the County Auditor in Deed Book K. at page (440) granted and conveyed in fee simple unto the said
