

FINN ET AL TO GAMMILL.

LITEN NOTICE.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that J. Gammill of Skamania County, Washington, claims alien upon that certain sawmill and sawmill business commonly known as "The Table Rock Mill" situated on Lots 1 and 2 and the West half of the North east quarter of Section 17, Township 2 North of Range 7 East of the Willamette Meridian in Skamania County, Washington, with all boilers, saws, belting, machinery, flumes, landings, roadways, donkey engine s and equipments, tools, imple-
ments and equipments of every kind and nature in or about or used in connection with said saw-
mill and all the real and personal property of said D. J. Finn and Walter S. Kilgore and Augusta
Kilgore, his wife, which is used in the operation of or in connection with said sawmill and
sawmill business including all the standing and cut timber on said described lands
and about 500 7x8 and 7x9 8 foot long saved fir railroad ties piled on the Spokane, Portland
& Seattle Railway's right of way at or near the water tank at Cascades station in said
Skamania County, Washington, about 150 7x8 and 7x9 railroad ties at the mill, about 200000
feet, board measure, fir sawlogs in the woods on said land prepared for use in said mill,
about 1500 feet, board measure, timbers at said mill and about 22000 feet board measure, fir
sawlogs at said mill, for work and labor performed in and about said sawmill and sawmill
business; that the amount of claimant's demand for said work and labor, after deducting all
just credits and offsets, is \$63.00; that the names of the persons owning and operating said
sawmill and sawmill business are D. J. Finn and Walter S. Kilgore and Augusta Kilgore, husband
and wife, that the name of the person employing this claimant is Walter S. Kilgore on behalf
of himself and the other said owners; that claimant states the terms and conditions of his
contract to be that said owners employed this claimant to labor in said sawmill at the agreed
wage of \$2.75 per day less the sum of 75 cents per day for board; that he commenced said work
on the 18th day of February, 1916; that he worked, pursuant to the terms of said contract
_____ days, which at said agreed wage amounted to the sum of \$103.25; that the date
of his last service under said contract was the 27th day of April, 1916; that during said
employment he received board and commissary supplies amounting to \$40.25 leaving a balance
due and owing and unpaid for said work and labor the sum of \$63.00 in which amount he claims
a lien upon the property above described.
