

## FINN ET AL TO VAN MAREN. AND NELSON.

## LIEN NOTICE.

G. Van Maren and Carl Nelson, Claimants.

vs

Walter S. Kilgore.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that G. VanMaren and Carl Nelson of Skamania County, State of Washington claim a lien upon a quantity of fir saw logs, being about 220000 feet in quantity and about 500 sawed fir railroad ties, said logs being 16.24 and 32 feet in length, and said ties being 7x8 and 7.9 & ft. long, which were cut or manufactured in Skamania County, State of Washington, are not marked, said logs now lying out the mill and in the woods on lots 1 and 2 and the West half of the Northeast quarter of Section 17 Township 2 North of Range 7 East of the Willamette Meridian, about a mile and a half north west from Cascades Station on the S P S Ry in said county and said ties now lying near the water tank at Cascades station on said railway in said County, for labor performed upon and assistance rendered in and about cutting, hauling and preparing said logs and ties for market; that the name of the owner or reputed owner is Walter S. Kilgore, that said walter S. Kilgore employed said G. Van. Maren and Carl Nelson to perform such labor and render such assistance upon the following terms and conditions to wit: the said Walter S. Kilgore agreed to pay said claimants 50 Cents per thousand feet, board measure, for cutting said logs for immediate use in the mill on said described land; that said contract has been faithfully performed and fully complied with on the part of said G. Van Maren and Carl Nelson, who performed labor upon and assisted in cutting and preparing said logs for said mill until the cut and prepared 286341 feet, board measure, under the terms and conditions of said contract; that said labor and assistance were so performed and rendered upon said sawlogs and ties between the 7th day of March, 1916, and the 21st day of April, 1916, and the rendition of said services closed on the 21st day of April, 1916, and thirty days have not elapsed since that time; that the amount of claimant's demand for said services is \$143.17; that no part thereof has been paid except the sum of \$85.55 and there is now due and remaing, unpaid thereon, after deducting all just credits and offsets, the sum of \$57.62 in which amount they claim a lien upon said logs and ties. The said claimants also claim a lien on all said logs and ties now owned by said Walter S. Kilgore of said county to secure payment for the work and labor in obtaining said logs and ties.
