Notice is hereby given, that on the 2nd day of August, 1939, the above named cl. mant, through the State Division of Forestry, commenced to perform labor upon and furnish materials in fighting a certain fire upon the following described property, to-wit:

Beginning at one-quarter corner on east side of Section 35, Township 3 North, Range 7 East, W. M., west 660 feet, south 1186 feet to center of Rock Creek; down stream along creek center to a point on east section line 750 feet south of start, north 750 feet to point of beginning, containing 14.43 acres (Skamania county)

of which property the owner or reputed owner is R. W. Thompson.

The performance of such labor and the furnishing of such materials was done under and pursuant to the Forest Protection Laws of the State of Washington, and more particularly to Section 5806 of Remington's Revised Statutes of the State of Washington.

The performance of the labor and the furnishing of the materials ceased on the 20th day of August, 1939; said labor performed and materials furnished were of the value of \$284.34 and not more than ninety days have elapsed since said named date, for which labor and materials the claimant claims a lien upon the property hereinbefore described for the said sum of two hundred eighty-four dollars and thirty-four cents (\$284.34).
