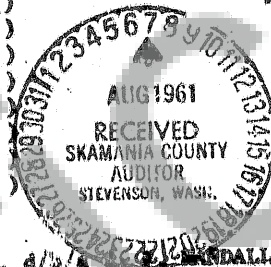

NOTICE OF CLAIM OF LIEN

The undersigned, C. P. RANDALL, d/b/a C. P. RANDALL MACHINE SHOP, of White Salmon, Klicitat County, Washington, commenced on or about July 24, 1961, the furnishing of certain materials, including a Carrier Heat Pump and duct material, plus installation services, at the special instance and request of GLEN JENSEN, contractor, which materials were to be used in the construction of a residence building situated on the following described real estate in Skamania County, Washington, to wit:

That the said GLEN JENSEN is the contractor of said building and the said LAURA E. JOHNSTON is the owner or reputed owner of said property and improvements thereon and had knowledge of and consented to the construction of said improvements on said real property; that within five days after the commencement of the furnishing of materials and labor by the undersigned to the said GLEN JENSEN, the undersigned notified the said owner and contractor by serving same with a notice of delivery of materials by material man in accordance with the statutes of the State of Washington; and that all of the above described real estate is necessary for the convenient use and occupation of the said building; and the said undersigned claimant claims a lien on said real property for the sum of \$2,490.00 for the furnishing of materials together with installation in said building.

I hat sixty days have not elapsed since the completion of furnishing by the undersigned claimant of said materials and installation services for said building.
