

Notice

I, P. S. C. Wells, owner of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 27 T 3 S R. 4E, by claim to and hereby give notice of appropriation of the water now being, lying and flowing across said land, in Rock Creek to the extent of 500 cubic feet per second of time, at or near the Stevenson Hot Springs, (formerly the Otter Hot Springs). 2. From data gathered, plans formed, work done and plant established upon said land, I claim the right to use any or all of said water so appropriated for generating water power, to dam and divert any or all of said Rock Creek water to facilitate the development and protection of said Hot Springs throughout development and thereafter. 3. I claim the right to use any or all of said water so appropriated for generating electric power for any purpose, for bathing, for wood working, irrigation and any or all the various uses of water and water power in connection with sanitariums, hotels and camps, grounds and their lawns, gardens, orchards, fish ponds and fountains. 4. I claim the right to divert by flume, ditch or pipe 500 cubic feet per second of time, the natural clear, wholesome Rock Creek water being, lying and flowing through said land and to convey same to Stevenson and vicinity by means of pipe, flume or ditch there to be used in all the varied uses of said Hot Springs sanitariums, hotels and camp grounds, fish ponds, bath houses and fountains.
