NOTICE OF CLAIM

Notice is hereby given that Delbert Garrett, Nestor Wilson, Laverne Randall, Ellis Vest and D. H. Dirks, the claimants above named, claim a lien upon one certain raft of logs and one certain raft of piling, being about 300,000 feet in quantity and one certain lot of logs in the woods at the scene of the logging operations, being about 200,000 feet in quantity, which were cut in Skamania County, State of Washington, are marked thus (A), and are lying in the mouth of Rock Creek in said Skamania County, for labor performed upon and assistance rendered in logging said logs and piling; that the name of the owner or reputed owner is Claud Kellum; that said owner employed said claimants above named to perform such labor and render such assistance upon the following terms and conditions, to-wit:

The said Claud Kellum agreed to pay the said Delbert Garrett for such labor and assistance the sum of 50 cents per thousand for all logs fell and bucked; that said contract has been faithfully performed and fully complied with on the part of said Delbert Garrett, who performed labor upon and assisted in logging said logs for the period of 32 days; that said labor and assistance were so performed and rendered upon said logs and piling between the 18th day of October and the 28th day of November; and the rendition of said service was closed on the 28th day of November, and 30 days have not elapsed since that time; that the amount of claimants demand for service is \$144.00; that no part thereof has been paid except \$24.23, and that there is now due and remaining unpaid thereon after deducting all just credits and offsets, the sum of \$119.77, which amount he claims a lien upon said logs and piling. The said Delbert Garrett also claims a lien on all said logs and timber now owned by said Claud Kellum to secure payment for the work and labor performed in obtaining the logs and piling herein described.

The said Claud Kellum agreed to pay to said Nestor Wilson for such labor and assistance the sum of 50 cents per thousand for all logs and piling fell and bucked; that said contract has been faithfully performed and fully complied with on the part of said Nestor Wilson, who performed labor upon and assisted in logging said logs for the period of 12 days; that said labor and assistance were so performed and rendered upon said logs and piling between the 18th day of November and the 28th day of November; and the rendition of said service was closed on the 28th day of November, and 30 days have not elapsed since that time; that the amount of claimants demand for service is \$54.00. That no part thereof has been paid except nothing, and that there is now due and remaining unpaid thereon after deducting all just credits and offsets, the sum of none, which amount he claims a lien upon said logs and piling. The said Nestor Wilson also claims a lien on all said logs and timber now owned by said Claud Kellum to secure payment for the work and labor performed in obtaining the logs and piling herein described.

The said Claud Kellum agreed to pay the said Laverne Randall for such labor and assistance the sum of 50 cents per thousand for all logs fell and bucked; that said contract has been faithfully performed and fully complied with on the part of said Laverne Randall, who performed labor upon and assisted in logging said logs for the period of

30 days; that said labor and assistance were so performed and rendered upon said logs and piling between the 19th day of October and the 28th day of November; and the rendition of said service was closed on the 28th day of November, and 30 days have not elapsed since that time; that the amount of claimants demand for service is \$135.00; that no part thereof has been paid except \$14.30, and that there is now due and remaining unpaid thereon after deducting all just credits and offsets, the sum of \$120.70, which amount he claims a lien upon said logs and piling. The said LaVern Randall also claims a lien on all said logs and timber now owned by said Claud Kellum to secure payment for the work and labor performed in obtaining the logs and piling herein described.

The said Claud Kellum agreed to pay to said Ellis Vest for such labor and assistance the sum of 50 cents per thousand for all logs and piling fell and bucked; that said contract has been faithfully performed and fully complied with on the part of said Ellis Vest, who performed labor upon and assisted in logging said logs for the period of 32 days; that said labor and assistance were so performed and rendered upon said logs and piling between the 19th day of October and the 28th day of November; and the rendition of said service was closed on the 28th day of November, and 30 days have not elapsed since that time; that the amount of claimants demand for service is \$144.00; that no part thereof has been paid except \$24.22 and that there is now due and remaining unpaid thereon after deducting all just credits and offsets, the sum of \$119.78, which amount he claims a lien upon said logs and piling. The said Ellis Vest also claims a lien on all said logs and timber now owned by said Claud Kellum to secure payment for the work and labor performed in obtaining the logs and piling herein described.

The said Claud Kellum agreed to pay to said D. H. Dirks for such labor and assistance the sum of 50 cents per thousand for all logs and piling fell and bucked; that said contract has been faithfully performed and fully complied with on the part of said D. H. Dirks, who performed labor upon and assisted in logging said logs for the period of 25 days; ----- that said labor and assistance were so performed and rendered upon said logs and piling between the 30th day of October and the 28th day of November; and the rendition of said service was closed on the 28th day of November, and 30 days have not elapsed since that time; that the amount of claimants demand for service is \$112.50; that no part thereof has been paid except \$10.00, leaving a balance due and owing of \$102.50 in which amount he claims a lien upon said logs and piling. The said D. H. Dirks also claims a lien on all said logs and timber now owned by said Claud Kellum to secure payment for the work and labor performed in obtaining the logs and piling herein described.
