That the said GLEN JENSEN is the contractor for said building and the said LAURA E. JOHNSTON is the owner or reputed owner of said property and the undersigned has knowledge of and is engaged in the construction of said improvements on said real property; that, within five days after the commencement of the furnishing of materials and labor by the undersigned to the said GLEN JENSEN, the undersigned notified the said owner and contractor by a written notice of delivery of materials by a special agent in accordance with the statutes of the State of Washington; and that all of the above described real estate is necessary for the convenient use and occupation of the said building; and the said undersigned is now claiming a lien on said real estate for the sum of \$630.18 for the furnishing of said materials for said building; that sixty days have elapsed since the expiration of the time for the
