Notice is hereby given that the above named petitioner has commenced an action against the above named claimant in the above entitled court and cause for the condemnation and appropriation of a right of way consisting of the following strips and tracts of land situated in the counties of Skamania and Clarkston, State of Washington and more particularly described as follows; to-wit: A strip of land two hundred feet wide being one hundred feet wide on each side of the center line of the survey of the Portland and Seattle Railway Company as the same was now surveyed and staked out through and across the east half of lot one and the west half of lot two of section twenty-three, township three north, range ten east of the Willamette Meridian, said center line being described as follows: Beginning at a point on the east line of the west half of lot two of said section twenty-three, known and designated as station 674+40 of said railway survey, thence on a spiral curve to the right 30.8 feet, thence north $69^{\circ} 41'$ west 645.2 feet, thence on a curve to the right having a radius of 573.0 feet a distance of 709 feet to a point on the west line of the east half of lot one of said section twenty-three, known and designated as station 688+25 of said railway survey, where the northwest corner of said lot one bears north $35^{\circ} 30'$ west 1136.3 feet, or so much of said strip as it is contained in one entire tract extending east and west on each side of the center line of the White Salmon River and between the line of ordinary high water of the Columbia River on the north and the southern line of lots one and two of said section twenty-three as shown by the United States survey of the same on the south.

Part the object of said petition is to condemn said right of way and to appropriate the whole of said described strips and tracts of land for the purpose of the construction of and operation of a line of railroad across said premises.
