

Notice of Water Right

Notice is hereby given that the undersigned hereby claims the water now being, lying and or flowing, to the rate of twenty cubic feet per second of time, in the creek known as Big Buck Creek in Twp. 3 N. 14. E. 18. W. Said water so claimed is for irrigation, fluming lumber or wood, municipal power uses, and may be used for any or all of these purposes at the following place to wit: at or near the town of Underwood, Washington.

The water so claimed will be diverted from said stream near the line between Secs 4 & Sec 5, at which said place a copy of this notice is posted, on a fir tree.

The means by which said water is to be converted to these uses is by ditch, flume, or pipe, to the place of intended use.
