Power of Convey To Convey Given Lands

Know all men by these Presents, That

Whereas, The Santa Fe Pacific Railroad Company, a corporation duly incorporated under an Act of Congress, approved March 3, 1897, has relinquished to the United States of America, under the Act of June 4, 1897, and June 6, 1905, the following described lands located within the San Francisco Mountains Forest Reserve, Territory of Arizona, to-wit:

The Southwest quarter of the Northwest quarter of section nineteen, township eighteen north, range eight east of the Gila and Salt River Base and Meridian, Arizona, containing forty acres more or less; And

Whereas, The Santa Fe Pacific Railroad Company is entitled to select, in lieu of the lands so relinquished to the United States, a like quantity of vacant, unreserved, non-mineral public lands of the United States which are subject to homestead entry;
