Power of Attorney To Convey Given Land.

I now do bind by these presents, That

Whereas, The Santa Fe Pacific Railroad Company, a corporation duly incorporated under an Act of Congress, approved March 3, 1897, has relinquished to the United States of America, under the date of June 4, 1897, and June 6, 1903, the following described lands located within the San Francisco Mountains Forest Reserve, Territory of Arizona, to wit:

The Southwest quarter of the Northwest quarter of section nineteen, township eighteen north, range eight east of the Gila and Salt River Base and Meridian, Arizona, containing forty acres more or less; and

Whereas, The Santa Fe Pacific Railroad Company is entitled to select, in view of the lands so relinquished to the United States, a like quantity of vacant, unoccupied, unimproved public lands of the United States which are subject to immediate entry;
