of America, to me paid by Thomas Clark
of the County of Skamania and State of Wash-
ington party of the second part, the receipt
of which is hereby acknowledged, do sell and
forever quit claim to the said party of the
second part, his heirs and assigns, all
my right, title and interest in and to the
following, described property, situate, lying
and being in the County of Skamania and
State of Washington and more particu-
larly described as follows, to-wit:

A certain Water right now owned by
or claimed by me, the following being
an exact copy: State of Washington
County of Skamania ss, Take Notice that
I have this day filed in the office of
the County Auditor of Skamania County,
Washington a Water right to be carried
by ditch or flume for irrigation and
fluming purposes, from a stream
commonly known as Smith Creek start-
ing from the homestead entry of W.A. Kie-
man and taking in the tributaries of the
said creek until sufficient water is
controlled to run irrigation and fluming
business, signed and sealed this 22nd day
of January, 1894 Signed Michael Lynott.
