

Power of Attorney

Know all men by these Presents, That Chicago Golden Brown Mining Company, by Joseph R. Seahl its President and Thomas A. Syner, its Secretary, of the City of Chicago, County of Cook in the State of Illinois, have made, constituted and appointed, and by these Presents does, make, constitute and appoint Clarence C.
