NOTICE OF LIEN.

W. H. CLARK VS. Claude Kellum, John Doe Wisdom, John Doe Barber:

Notice is hereby given that W. H. Clark of Skamania County, state of Washington, claims a lien upon a quantity of saw logs, being about 124000 board feet woods scale, which were cut or manufactured in Skamania county, state of Washington, are marked X, and are now lying in Rock Creek at Stevenson, said County and State, for labor performed upon and assistance rendered in scaling said saw logs; that Claude Kellum, John Doe Wisdom and John Doe Barber employed said W. H. Clark to perform such labor and render such assistance upon the following terms and conditions, to-wit:

The said Claude Kellum, John Doe Wisdom and John Doe Barber agreed to pay the said W. H. Clark for such labor and assistance at the rate of twenty five cents per thousand feet with a guarantee of \$3.00 per day; that said contract has been faithfully performed and fully complied with on the part of the said W. H. Clark who performed labor upon and assisted in scaling said logs for a period of _____; that said labor and assistance was so performed and rendered upon said logs between the 30th day of April, 1940 and the 20th day of June, 1940; and the rendition of said services was closed on the 19th day of June, 1940 and thirty days have not elapsed since that time; that the amount of claimants demand for said service is \$103.67; that no part thereof has been paid, and there is now due and remaining unpaid thereon after deducting all just credits and offsets, the sum of \$103.67,
