To whom it may concern: Notice do hereby give that "The Stevens Security and Investment Company" a corporation duly organized and incorporated under and by virtue of the laws of the State of Washington for the purpose among other things, of manufacturing lumber and other articles, with its principal office and place of business at the town of Stevens in said County and State, claims, takes possession of and appropriates to its own use and benefit for manufacturing power, domestic and water supply purposes, all the water flowing in and along "Rock creek" at what is commonly known as the lower falls of said creek situated in the North East corner first acre square, of the South West quarter of the Southeast quarter of Section Thirty-six (36) in Township three (3) North of Range Seven (7) East of Willamette Meridian in the County and State aforesaid; said falls being near the North line of the said South West quarter of the Southeast quarter of Section Thirty-six (36) and likewise claims and takes possession of and appropriates to its own use and benefit one hundred cubic feet of water per second of flowing in said creek and over and through said lower falls at the point last aforesaid for the purpose hereinbefore stated. Said water to be used at and adjacent to said lower falls and in and near the town of Stevens aforesaid.
