

Le Roy Neil Wheeldon, claimant vs. Pacific Lumber and Shipping Company

Notice is hereby given that Le Roy Neil Wheeldon of Longview Cowlicks County, Washington, claims a lien upon a quantity of Logs and Timber, being about six hundred thousand board feet (600,000) more or less in quantity, which were cut in Skamania County, State of Washington, and stated that:

and are now afloat in waters of Columbia River or on dockside or aboard ship at Longview, Skamania County, Washington, under the control of said above named PACIFIC LUMBER AND SHIPPING COMPANY, for labor performed upon and assistance rendered in cutting, yarding, hauling and delivering said logs and timber; that the name of the owner or reputed owner PACIFIC LUMBER AND SHIPPING COMPANY; that said HOWARD NEWTON LOGGING COMPANY EMPLOYED SAID CLAIMANT ABOVE NAMED to perform such labor and render such assistance upon the following terms and conditions:

Claimant was to furnish cutting and yarding on said logs and timber for the agreed price of \$15.00 per thousand for salvage lower ends of logs and \$20.00 per thousand board feet of logs and timber cut and yarded

That said HOWARD NEWTON LOGGING COMPANY agreed to pay claimant on the foregoing agreement cash upon performance of said work and services, being labor and assistance, the sum of \$4,500.00; the said contract has been fully performed and faithfully complied with on the part of the said LEROY NEIL WHEELDON, who performed labor and assisted in cutting and yarding said logs and timber for the period of 20 days; that the said labor and services performed on said logs and timber was during the period between the 21st day of August, 1964 and the 18th day of September, 1964, and the rendition of the service and labor was closed the 18th day of September, 1964; that no part thereof has been paid; that thirty days have not elapsed since the ceasing of said work and services; that there is now due and owing \$4,500.00, after deducting all just credits and offsets, in which he claims an alien on all said logs and timber, now owned by said Pacific Lumber and Shipping Company of said county to secure payment for work and labor performed in obtaining or securing said logs and timber herein described.

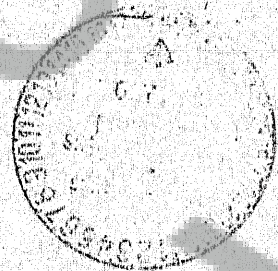
STATEMENT AND CLAIM OF LIEN

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN That the State of Washington through its Department of Labor and Industries claims a lien prior to all other liens, except taxes, upon any and all of the real estate, plant, works, equipment and buildings improved, operated or constructed by the above named employer and also upon any and all logs, spars, piles, ties and any and all other timber produced, and any and all articles manufactured by said above named employer, which property is now located in the County of Skamania, State of Washington, and is more particularly described as follows, to-wit:

Real Estate

LOCATED AT: All that portion of Lots 5 and 12 of Seeley's Sub-division of the South West 1/4 of Section 19-3-10 which lies Easterly of Ansplund Road.
Deed Reference No. 46-215 and 49-453.



This lien is upon, and to secure the payment of, an account of and for industrial insurance and medical aid premiums or assessments and penalties due the industrial insurance and medical aid funds of the State of Washington, all of which aggregate Two Hundred Twenty-nine and 88/100 (\$229.88) Dollars, and all of which were incurred under and by virtue of the operations of said employer in which workmen were employed under the provisions of Title 51 of the Revised Code of Washington.

This lien shall date from the commencement of the labor for and on account of which said premiums or assessments and penalties are due, to-wit: July 1, 1963.

The said employer made report to the Department of Labor and Industries of his pay rolls upon said operations and defaulted in the payment of said premiums or assessments due thereon upon the 31st day of January, 1964, and ever since said last mentioned date has been and now is in default to said State of Washington for said account, which is more particularly set forth as follows, to-wit:
