The claim of claimant is for the hauling and trucking of said logs as aforesaid; that the names of ... owners or reputed owners of said logs are as follows: Mart Caswell, Caswell Logging Co., Inc.; Fort Vancouver Plywood, Inc.; Portland Lumber Mills, Inc.; Portland Manufacturing Co.; Rainier Manufacturing Co., Inc.; and Vancouver Plywood, Inc.
