



CLAIM OF LIEN



NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that DAVE MORGAN of 2444 - 34th St., Longview, Cowlitz County, Washington, claims a lien upon various rafts of logs being about 250,000 board feet in quantity, the same having been felled, bucked and yarded in Sections 6 and 8, Township 7 North, Range 6 E. of Willamette Meridian in Skamania County, Washington, and trucked and hauled by claimant from said location to the Kerry Log Dump at Woodland, Cowlitz County, Washington, with an occasional load to Longview, Washington; said logs being marked and branded thus R. 1/; said logs now being and lying at the Kerry Log Dump at Woodland, Cowlitz County, Washington, and at various other places on the Columbia River. The claim of claimant is for the hauling and trucking of said logs as aforesaid; that the names of the owners or reputed owners of said logs are as follows: Mert Caswell, Caswell Logging Co., Inc.; Fort Vancouver Plywood, Inc.; Portland Lumber Mills, Inc.; Portland Manufacturing Co.; Rainier Manufacturing Co., Inc.; and Vancouver Plywood, Inc. That Mert Caswell and the Caswell Logging Co., Inc., employed claimant to perform the hauling and trucking of said logs upon the following terms and conditions, to-wit: That claimant was to be paid the sum of Fifty-two and no/100 (\$52.00) Dollars per load for each load of logs hauled by him from the said logging site in

Skamania County to the said Kerry Log Dump at Woodland, Washington; that 40 such loads were hauled by claimant between September 20, 1964, and November 5, 1964, inclusive; that said work has been done by claimant and he has fully and faithfully performed the work and fully complied with the agreement on his part, and he did and performed such work and such trucking and hauling as aforesaid from September 20, 1964, to November 5, 1964, inclusive; that said labor and services and hauling and trucking were all performed within said period; and the rendition of said labor, services, trucking and hauling was closed on November 5, 1964, and thirty (30) days have not elapsed since that time; that the amount of claimant's demand for said labor, services, hauling and trucking is the sum of \$2047.00; that no part of said sum has been paid; and there is now due and remaining unpaid thereon, after deducting all just credits and offsets, the sum of \$2047.00, in which amount he claims a lien upon said logs, the same being in rafts K93, K99, K102, K110, K95, K98, K102, K106, K109, K115, as prepared and boomed by the Kerry Log Rafting Co., at its Woodland, Cowlitz County, Washington, log dump, the same being now owned by Mert Caswell of Woodland, Washington; Caswell Logging Co., Inc., of Woodland, Washington; Portland Manufacturing Co., Portland, Oregon; Portland Lumber Mills, Inc., of Portland, Oregon; Fort Vancouver Plywood, Inc., Vancouver, Washington; Rainier Manufacturing Co., Inc., of Rainier, Oregon; and Vancouver Plywood, Inc., of Vancouver, Washington, to secure payment for the labor, services, trucking and hauling performed in the obtaining and securing of said logs herein described. That claimant claims a lien upon all logs and timber owned by said persons and parties for the work done as set forth herein.


