Notice is hereby given that I, the undersigned, do hereby claim the water now lying, being and flowing in that certain creek known as Devil Creek in Sec. 20 Twp. 2 N.R. 7 E. W.M.  
Klamath Co. Wash., to the extent of one cubic foot per second of time. The water so appropriated is for the purposes of irrigating, domestic purposes and for fluming cordwood and lumber to the Columbia River at nearest and most practicable route. 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Power of Attorney

I, know all men by these presents, That Whereas, by an act of Congress, approved June 9, 1897 (30 Stat. 36) it is provided: That in cases in which a tract covered by a patent is included within the limits of a public forest reservation, the owner thereof may, if he desires to do so, relinquish the tract to the Government, and may to select in lieu thereof a tract of vacant land open to settlement etc. And, Whereas on the 8th day of February 1904, the of the Land and Lumber Company Limited, a corporation organized and existing under and by virtue of the laws of the State of New York, was the owner of the following lands and by virtue of the laws of the State of New York, was the owner of the following described land: One fourth part of the North West quarter of Section Twenty-one (21) in Township eleven (11) North; Range nineteen (19) East, Sila and Salt River Mountain, in the County of Klamath, Territory of Oregon, which said tract prior to said date, had been included within the limits of the Black Bear Forest Reserve; And Whereas, on the said last named day the said company surrendered the said land to the United States by deed of conveyance duly executed by which it became entitled to select other lands of equal acreage in lieu thereof. Now, Therefore, the said of the Land and Lumber Company, Limited, his male, constituted and appointed, and by these presents does make, constitute and appoint Rollin R. Young, of Medford in the County of Klamath, State of Oregon, its true and lawful attorney for it in its name, place and stead, to enter into and take possession of each and every tract of public land in any State or Territory of the United States that has been or may hereafter be selected by it in lieu of the land surrendered to the United States as aforesaid, in any portion thereof whether the said selection or selections be made by it personally, or by some one else acting through, power of attorney from it.
