 Washington and also all my right to the

 wheel and also all my right title and interest
 in and to a piece of real estate known on the U.S.
 Land office maps as Lot one (1) in the aforesaid
 Section thirty-one (31) in said Skamania County
 and State of Washington, To have and to hold

 and to his heirs and assigns forever In witness
