

Nature of Water Location

Knows all men by these presents that the undersigned by virtue of the rights given them by the laws and statutes of the United States and local customs of the State of Washington does hereby claim the water of these streams known as Coldwater and having its source in ~~unincorporated~~ Government land and within the proposed Mount Rainier National Reserve, the water supply is furnished by several small lakes and mountain streams in the above lake range, one of the lakes being ^{that} the same. Situated in Skamania County and which is termed the St. Helens Mining District, State of Washington. The water hereby claimed flows almost due southward into the middle fork of the Twelfth River, in boundary county State of Washington. The amount of water hereby claimed is in amount of about 20000 cubic feet per second of time. The purpose of this claim is to divert the water as above described and appropriated into a flume or pipe, and convey said water through a portion of said county to some point as near as can be determined in section 11 Township 9 North Range 4 East W. M. from this notice and there ~~being~~ utilized for mining, milling and manufacturing purposes, generating electricity for power purposes supplying water to towns, cities and villages or otherwise. It is intended to divert the above described water by placing in the stream at point of diversion a concrete box of suitable proportion to conduct the said water into the pipe flume or open ditch as may be determined. The exact place of diversion cannot be determined but will be on about there and one half miles from head water, at the point where this notice is posted more or less.
