Notice is hereby given that LYLE SLAGHT, Rt. 1, Box 512, Rainier, Columbia County, Oregon, and HAROLD E. VAUGHN, of 135 Buland Drive, Castle Rock, Cowlitz County, Washington, claim a lien upon logs which were cut or manufactured in Skamania County, State of Washington, being about 750,000 feet, now lying in pond at Kerry Log Dump, Woodland, Cowlitz County, Washington, marked (R-114), lying in various rafts Nos. K93, K99, K103, K110, K95, K102, K106, K109, K115, and one lot of which, marked W-114, is lying in an area known as West Pine Government Sale on the Lewis River, and in Section 7 and 8, Township 7 North, Range 6 East of W. M., Skamania County, Washington, for labor performed, assistance rendered in obtaining, securing and hauling said logs; that the name of the owner or reputed owner is Merton F. Caswell, Caswell Logging Co., Inc., Portland Manufacturing Co., Portland Mills, Inc., Fort Vancouver Plywood, Inc., Rainier Manufacturing Co., Inc., and Vancouver Plywood, Inc.; that Merton F. Caswell employed said claimants to perform such labor and render such assistance upon the following terms and conditions, to wit: Lyle Slaght, Mechanic, Straight-time labor, \$3.00, Overtime labor, \$4.50; Harold E. Vaughn, Rigging, Straight-time labor, \$3.25, Overtime labor, \$4.88, and Choker Setter, Straight-time labor, \$2.75, Overtime labor, \$4.13; that said contracts have been faithfully performed and fully complied with on the part of said claimants who performed labor and furnished assistance in the obtaining, securing and hauling said logs between the 30th day of September, 1964, and the 7th day of November, 1964; and the rendition of said services and assistance was closed on the 7th day of November, 1964, and thirty days have not elapsed since that time; that the amount of claimants' demands for said labor and service is Lyle Slaght, \$178.50, and Harold E. Vaughn, \$612.87; that no part thereof has been paid except the sum of \$150.00 to Harold E. Vaughn, and there is now due and remaining unpaid thereon, after deducting all just credits and offsets, the sum of \$178.50 to Lyle Slaght, and the sum of \$462.87 to Harold E. Vaughn, in which amount the above named claimants claim a lien upon all said logs, together with the franchise, earnings, and all the real and personal property and all logs now owned by the said Merton F. Caswell, Caswell Logging Co., Inc., Portland Manufacturing Co., Portland Mills, Inc., Fort Vancouver Plywood, Inc., Rainier Manufacturing Co., Inc., and Vancouver Plywood, Inc., which is used in the operation of their businesses, owned by said persons, firms, or corporations to secure the payment for the work and labor performed in obtaining or securing the said logs, spars, piles or other timber, lumber or shingles herein described.

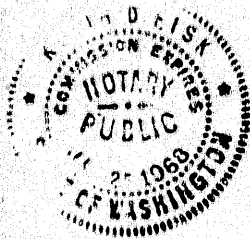
