

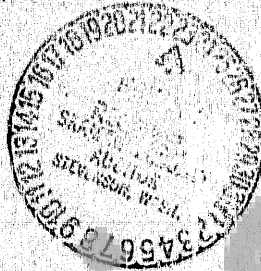
LIEN FOR LABOR AND SERVICES ON
TIMBER AND LUMBER

Notice is hereby given that GEORGE D. CONFER, of Cowlitz County, State of Washington, claims a lien upon cut timber and logs, being a quantity which were cut in Skamania County, State of Washington and are marked with a brand "PM-1", and are now lying on land owned by the State of Washington in the area of West Pine Government Sale on the Lewis River and in a pond located at Karry Log Dump, Woodland, Washington, for labor performed upon and assistance rendered in logging, yarding and loading said logs; that the name of the owner or reputed owner is Merton F. Caswell, Caswell Logging Company, and/or Portland Mills, Inc.; that Merton F. Caswell employed said George D. Confer to perform such labor and render such assistance upon the following terms and conditions, to-wit: That said Merton F. Caswell agreed to pay said George D. Confer for such labor and assistance as required at the rate of approximately \$26.00 per day; that said contract has been fully performed and fully complied with on the part of said George D. Confer who performed labor upon and assisted in logging, yarding and loading said timber and logs for the period of October 1, 1964 to November 5, 1964; and that said labor and assistance were so performed and rendered upon said timber and logs between October 1, 1964 and November 5, 1964 and that thirty days have not elapsed since that time; that the amount claimant demands for said services is \$71.11, in which amount he claims a lien upon said timber and logs. That said George D. Confer also claims a lien on all said timber and logs now owned by said Merton F. Caswell, Caswell Logging Company and Portland Mills, Inc. to secure payment for the work and labor performed in obtaining or securing the said logs, spars, piles, or other timber, lumber or shingles herein described.
