Presumption of right of way for ditch and location of flume line.

To whom these presents may come know ye that the St. Helens Ore mill and power company a corporation duly incorporated and organized under the laws of the State of Washington, and having their principal office of business in Seattle, Washington, and branch offices in any part of the United States but more particularly in Hagerston, Id. do hereby declare and publish as a legal notice to all the world, that it is company claims and has a legal right to the possession and occupation and enjoyment of all and singular that track or parcel of land lying and being in the County of Shumner, State of Washington, for the exclusive right of way for the purpose of constructing flume line or water ditch from middle fork of Tenth River being the outlet of Spirit Lake some time known as St. Helens Lake, more particularly described as follows:

The first Terminal point begins from a corner post marked U. S. L. M. at North West corner of section 20, Township 4, North Range 6 East W. M. thence through unswayed land 18350 feet to the North bank of the main outlet of Spirit Lake in Shumner county, State of Washington, thence westerly through unswayed land 27000, to Western terminal of flume line, thence westerly through unswayed land 1485 feet, length of peas took line Terminal, thence North 1420 feet connecting at corner post of North East corner of Section 13, Township 9 N. R. 4 E. W. M. U. S. L. M. all of which is more fully described in the field notes and maps. The flume line and peastock line is located on the North side of the Tenth River and within the proposed Mt. Rainier Forest Reserve, in the Vancouver Land District, Washington; Fifty feet is claimed on each side of the center of the survey which was made in the year of 1905, beginning on the 11. day of August ending on the 10. day of September. The company also claims and has a valid right to 20 000 cubic feet of water per second of time from said stream, for mining, milling and manufacturing purposes to be conveyed through said flume or ditch as above described, together with all and singular, hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging or in anywise appertaining.
