 Two Hundred and twenty Dollars in hand paid
 by the said Party of the second part, the receipt
 of which is hereby acknowledged, have sold, and
 by these presents do hereby Grant, Bargain, Sell
 and Convey unto the said Party of the second
 part, his Heirs and assigns, forever, all the full
 & owning described real estate, lying and being
 situated in the County of Skamania and State of
 Washington, to-wit:

The North East Quarter (NE $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section
 Seventeen (17) in Township No 3 North, of Range
 6 East of Willamette Meridian containing 160 acres
 together with all and singular the, Privil-
 eges, tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances
 therunto belonging or in anywise appertaining.
 To Have and to Hold the same, to the said
 Party of the second part his Heirs and assigns
 forever.
