Now at this time comes Catherine Haffey, the widow or relict of said Wm Haffey, deceased, and presents and files in this Court her petition praying that a Homestead, as now provided by law for the head of a family, be set apart out of the real estate of said estate and described in the inventory and appraisement, herin filed for the use and support of said widow and her minor child Cornelius Haffey; and also praying that all of the personal property returned in said inventory and appraisement herin, as would be by law exempt from execution be also set apart for the use and support of the said widow and said minor child, Cornelius Haffey.

And it appearing to the Court, that on the 16th day of April, 1894, Cornelius O'Hanlon, the duly appointed, qualified and acting Administrator of said estate, filed in this Court his inventory and appraisement of said estate, and that the appraised value of all of the real property of said estate is \$7516.00 and that the appraised value of all of the personal property, not including notes and accounts is \$771.30; and that the appraised value of all of the notes and accounts is \$113.89, making in all the sum of \$8401.19, which sum is the total appraised value of the estate of said Wm Haffey, deceased, and that all of the estate of the said deceased is
