And it further appearing to the Court that out of the personal property, belonging to said estate, as set forth in said inventory and appraisement, said widow is entitled, for the use of herself and her said minor child, to all the property of the estate, which, by law, would be exempt from execution, and that of the said personal property so set forth and returned in said inventory and appraisement, she is entitled by law to the following described property, to wit:

One four year old horse, appraised at \$30;
 One 8 year old mare, appraised at \$50.00;
 one set of harness, appraised at \$5.00; One wagon, appraised at \$15.00; 1 Mower; 1 Turbine binder; 1 Plow; 2 old harrows; 2 old potato forks; 2 old hoes; 4 hay forks; 1 grubbing hoe; 1 grind stone; 1 log chain; 1 cross cut saw; one half interest in an old thrashing machine; 1 buck saw; 2 old axes; 3 old shovels; 1 crow bar; 2 hammers; 3 wood chisels; 1 monkey wrench; 1 rasp; 1 Brace and bits; 2 cast iron wrenches; 1 drawing knife; 4 spools of barbed wire; 1 churn; 53 milk pans; 3 dish pans; 1 Raking machine; 1 Piece of one inch rope; 3 empty barrels; 1 butter churn; 1 butter mold; 2 cook stoves; all of said named articles or utensils being in actual use on the farm and not exceeding in value \$500.00 in coin, Also 150 bushels of oats; 50 bushels of potatoes to be used
