

Notice

J. R. L. Gate, hereby give to notice to all whom it may concern, that I hereby appropriate all the water 1000 cubic feet per second of the flow of Rock Creek in the County of Skamania, State of Washington, near the Town of Stevenson, and more particularly described, as being in the North Eastern part of the South west quarter of the South west quarter of Section No. 36 in Township Three North, of Range Seven, East of the Willamette Meridian.

The purpose for which said water is appropriated is for use in the production of electric power, water power, water supply for domestic and power use in and near the town of Stevenson, Skamania County, State of Washington, and for manufacturing purposes and uses of all kinds and characters, and for all other uses to which said water may be beneficially put. The water hereby appropriated is to be diverted at or near the falls known as the Lower Falls upon the lands above described and conducted in pipes, flumes, ditches, or otherwise, to such point or points from such falls as shall be convenient to build power houses and to procure the full power of such falls, said diversion to be effected by means of dams, so as to turn such water into such pipes, flumes, or ditches, such dams to be erected at or immediately above such falls, and such power houses to be erected at whatever points downstream from such falls or at such points as shall be most convenient for the best use of said water, or such pipes as shall be used to convey water for power and domestic uses shall be filled by means of dams at or near said falls, but it being intended to appropriate and use the water of said Rock Creek - as to receive the full power produced by said falls, and the water so diverted or the electric or other power produced therefrom it is intended to use and apply for the purposes above stated in Skamania County, Washington, or across the Columbia River in the State of Oregon, and at such places as it may be profitable so to use it.
