Notice is hereby given that the undersigned, Buck Creek Lumber Company, Mick Thornton, Manager, claim the water from this stream, known as the Buck Creek all of the water running or flowing in said stream to the extent of 30 cubic foot of water per second of time being equal to 1200 inches inches. The purpose for which said water so appropriated is for household, personal & manufacturing, domestic and irrigation purposes, and the place of intended use is the farm or premises of the above mentioned appropriator which premises are particularly described as follows:

NW  $\frac{1}{4}$  NE  $\frac{1}{4}$  and other portions of Section 2 ad Township 3 north of Range 10, east of the Willamette River. The means by which it is intended to divert the water from said stream is a head gate which shall be located at the point on the right bank on a fir tree from which the  $\frac{1}{4}$  corner between sections 2 & 3 is Township 3 north of range 10 east of the Willamette River bearing N. 56° 37' E. 186 feet distant, and said water shall be diverted and conveyed from said head gate by means of a ditch and flume of sufficient size and carrying capacity to carry said water to said premises above mentioned and described.
