Notice is hereby given that the undersigned, Buck Creek Lumber Company, Mick Thornton, Manager, claim the water from their stream, known as the Buck Creek, all of the water running or flowing in said stream to the extent of 30 cubic feet of water per second of time being equal to 1200 minims inches.
