I, R. L. Gate, hereby give notice to all whom it may concern, that I hereby appropriate all the water, to wit, 1000 cubic feet per second of the flow of Rock Creek in the County of Skamania, State of Washington, and more particularly described as being in the North-east quarter of Section Twenty seven, Township Three, North of Range Seven East of the Willamette Meridian.

The purposes for which said water is appropriated is for use in the production of electric power, water power, water supply for domestic and power uses in and near the town of Stevenson, Skamania County, State of Washington and for manufacturing purposes and uses of all kinds and characters, and for all other uses to which said water may be beneficially put.

The water hereby appropriated is to be diverted at or near the springs in said Rock Creek known as the Stevenson Hot Springs, more particularly described as being in the North west quarter of the North-east quarter of Section Twenty seven, Township Three North of Range Seven East of the Willamette Meridian and conducted in pipes, flumes, ditches or otherwise, to such point or points from such point of diversion as shall be convenient to build power houses and to procure the full power of such creek, said

diversion to be effected by means of dams and such power houses to be erected at whatever points downstream from said point or at such points as shall be most convenient for the best use of said water or such pipes as shall be used to convey water for power and domestic use shall be filled by means of dams at or near said point of diversion, but it being intended to appropriate and use the water of said Rock Creek so as to receive the full power produced by said stream and the water so diverted or the electric or other power produced therefrom, it is intended to use and apply for the purposes above stated in Skamania County, Washington, or across the Columbia River in the State of Oregon, and at such places as it may be profitable so to use it.
