

Robert A. Hill "to" John Huth

The Mortgagee Robert A. Hill unmortgaged, of Skamania County, Wash. mortgage to John Huth the property hereinafter described to secure the payment of Three Hundred Dollars according to the terms of a certain promissory note, of which the following is substantially a copy, to-wit:

$\$300 \frac{00}{100}$ Vancouver, Wash, December 18, 1894

Three years after date, without date, without grace, for value received, I promise to pay to John Huth or order, at Vancouver Wash, Three hundred and $\frac{00}{100}$ Dollars, with interest from date at the rate of ten per cent, per annum, interest payable semi annually, and if not so paid, the whole sum of both principal and interest to become immediately due and collectible, at the option of the holder of this note. If not so collected, the interest to be added to and become part of the principal, and the same to bear interest thereafter, until paid, at the rate of twelve per cent per annum. Principal and interest payable in U.S. Gold Coin. And in case action is commenced to enforce payment of this note, or any portion thereof I promise to pay such additional sum as the Court may adjudge reasonable as attorneys fees in said action.
