

Stuart Rice, Receiver to W^m W. Archer & Fth A. Brown

This Indenture, Made this Seventh day of June Eighteen hundred ninety-five, between Stuart Rice as receiver of the Washington National Bank of Tacoma, party of the first part, and William W. Archer and Frederick A. Brown, parties of the second part.

Witnesseth, That, whereas, the said Stuart Rice, said party of the first part, was on the twenty sixth day of August, eighteen hundred ninety three, appointed receiver of The Washington National Bank of Tacoma, by the Honorable James H. Eckels, Comptroller of the Currency of the United States, in pursuance of the power and authority vested in said Comptroller by law, and under the provisions of Section one of An Act of Congress of the United States, authorizing the appointment of receivers of national banks and for other purposes, approved June thirtieth, eighteen hundred seventy six.

And, Whereas, on the seventh day of June, eighteen hundred ninety five, upon petition of the said Stuart Rice to the Superior Court of the State of Washington for the County of Pierce, in the matter of The Washington National Bank of Tacoma, an order was duly entered on said day authorizing and directing the said Stuart Rice to make this conveyance with other conveyances.

Now This Indenture Witnesseth: That the said party of the first part, as such receiver, in pursuance of said appointment, and of said order duly entered in the said Superior Court of the State of Washington for the County of Pierce on the seventh day of June, eighteen hundred ninety five, duly authorizing him so to do, and in consideration of the sum of Eight Hundred Dollars to him paid by the said parties of the second part, for the property hereinafter described, together with other property, does hereby Grant, Bargain, Sell, Convey, Assign and Transfer
