That said Lewellen was to pay said Whitten and Bartlett for falling, bucking, yarding, loading and hauling of said logs at the following rates: peeler logs, \$18.00 per thousand, peeler blocks, \$17.00 per thousand, fir logs, \$13.00 per thousand, cedar logs, \$13.00 per thousand; that said O. P. Lewellen agreed to pay said Noyes Whitten and F. L. Bartlett for such labor and assistance in falling, bucking, yarding, hauling and loading said logs and said contract was faithfully performed and complied with on the part of said Noyes Whitten and F. L. Bartlett, who performed labor upon and assisted in said logging operation from the 21st day of May, 1941, to the 29th day of September, 1941; that said labor and assistance were so performed and rendered between the 21st day of May, 1941, and the 29th day of September, 1941, and rendition of said services closed on the 29th day of September, 1941; that thirty days have not elapsed since said date.

That the amount of claimants' demand for said services is \$42,723.41; that no part thereof has been paid excepting the sum of \$37,756.02, that there is now due, owing and remaining unpaid thereon after deducting all credits and offsets the sum of \$4967.39, in which amount they claim a lien upon said logs.

That said Noyes Whitten and F. L. Bartlett also claim a lien upon all of said logs now owned by said O. P. Lewellen of said County, to secure the work and labor performed in obtaining said logs or other timber herein described.
