the South East-quarter of Section Fourteen (14)
all in Township Two (2) North, Range Five (5)
East of the Willamette Meridian

To have and to hold the same, together
with all and singular, the hereditaments and appur-
tenances therewith belonging, or in anywise apper-
taining to the said W W Curtis, Trustee, and
to his successors forever.
