HAMFIELD, d/b/a RIVAL HARDWARE & SUPPLY CO., contracted with said owners or reputed owners of said property who had knowledge of and consented to the furnishing of said materials on the above-described real property. Further, that the undersigned continued to furnish materials to be used in said building from the said date of August 26, 1966, to the 17th day of October, 1966, to the said owners. That all of the above described real estate is necessary for the construction, use and occupation of the said building; and the said undersigned claimant claims a lien on said real property for the sum of \$1,000.00 for the furnishing of materials in said building.

That the undersigned ceased furnishing of materials for the above named owners on October 17, 1966, and that every day have not elapsed since

the execution of said plan by the government of said materials
for said building.
