Notice is hereby given that the State of Washington through its Department of Labor and Industries claims a lien prior to all other liens, except taxes, upon ^{any} and all of the real estate, plant, works, equipment and buildings improved, operated or constructed by the above named employer and also upon any and all logs, spars, piles, ties and any and all other timber produced, and any and all articles manufactured by said above named employer, which property is now located in the County of Klickitat, State of Washington, and is more particularly described as follows, to-wit:
