 Eugene T. Mandeville and Delia W. Mandeville his
 wife, of Oregon City, Oregon, for and in con-
 sideration of the sum of One Hundred Dollars
 to us in hand paid, the receipt whereof is
 hereby acknowledged, have Bargained, Sold &
 Conveyed, and by these presents do Bargain
 Sell and Convey unto David H. Gary the follow-
 ing described premises, to-wit:

Lots three (3) and four (4) and the
 East half of the South West quarter of Section
 (7) in Township Two (2) North of Range Five
 (5) East of the Willamette Meridian, Containing
 One hundred and Sixty eight & $\frac{4}{100}$ acres
 all in Skamania County, State of Washington

Together with the tenements, hereditaments
 and appurtenances therunto belonging or in
 any wise appertaining.

To Have and to Hold the same, with the
 appurtenances unto the said David H. Gary
 his heirs and assigns, forever.

 paid, for value received; and in case suit
 or action is instituted to collect this note, or
 any portion thereof, we promise to pay such
 additional sum as the Court may adjudge.
