

Notice of Waterright

To all whom these presents may concern: Be it known that Britt. E. Larson, John Anderson
and Britt O. Larson of Home Valley in said County and State, does hereby publish and declare
as a legal notice to all the world, I. That we have a legal right to the use, possession and control
of and claim (300) three hundred minor inches of the waters of Little West River in said
County and State for irrigating purposes. II. That the special purpose for which said water
is appropriated and the place of intended use is indicated in Sec. 18. Twp. A. S. R. W. M. to be
used for irrigating and other purposes (domestic, industrial etc) etc. That we have taken
said water out of and diverted it from said stream by means of flumes and ditches
which said flumes & ditches are 10 inches by 30 inches in size and carries about 300 inches
of water from said stream; said flumes & ditch take and divert the water from said
stream at a point upon its easterly bank at a point indicated in Sec. 18. T. 3 R. 8. S. W. M.
there running in a southwesterly direction to the place above mentioned. III. That we
appropriated and took said water on the 9th day of Sept. 1907 by means of said
acknowledgment and notice posted at place of diversion. IV. That the names of
the appropriators of said water Britt E. Larson, John Anderson, Britt O. Larson.
V. That we also hereby claim said ditch and water as the right of my thereof
and for said water by it conveyed, or to be conveyed and also the right of location upon
my lands of my dams, flumes, reservoirs, constructed or to be constructed by us in
using said water.

Placing the same, all and singular, under my laws and all laws, National and
State, and the rulings and decisions thereunder in the matter of water rights.
Together with all and singular the hereditaments and appurtenances thereto belonging or
pertaining or to accrue to the same.
