

*Notice of Waterright*

To all whom these Presents may concern: Be it known that Orin E. Larson, John Anderson and Orin O. Larson of Horse Valley in said County and State, does hereby publish and declare as a legal notice to all the world, I. That we have a legal right to the use, possession and control of and claim (300; three hundred million inches of the waters of Little Wind River in said County and State for irrigating purposes. II. That the special purpose for which said water is appropriated and the place of intended use is situated in Sec. 14, T. 3. R. 8 E. W. 4 N. to be used for irrigating and other purposes (domestic, industrial etc) etc. That we have taken said water out of and diverted it from said stream by means of flumes and ditches which said flumes & ditches is 10 inches by 30 inches in size and carries about 300 inches of water from said stream; said flumes & ditch lays and divert the water from said Stream at a point upon its easterly bank at a point situated in Sec. 12, T. 3 R. 8 E. W. 4 N. thence running in a southwesterly direction to the place above mentioned. III. That we appropriated and took said water on the 9th day of Sep. 1907 by means of said acknowledgment and notice posted at place of Diversion. IV. That the names of the appropriators of said water Orin E. Larson, John Anderson, Orin O. Larson. V. That we also hereby claim said ditch and waterway the right of way thereof and for said water right conveyed, or to be conveyed and also the right of location upon any lands of any dunes, flumes, reservoirs, constructed or to be constructed by us in using said Water.

Flaming the same, all and singular, under any laws and all laws, National and State, and the rulings and decisions thereunder in the matter of waterright.

Together with all and singular the hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging or appertaining or to accrue to the same.
