Pro- Description of Right of way for Ditch and location of Water.
To Whom these presents may concern, Know ye, That H. C. Eckenberger, of the County
of Multnomah, in the State of Oregon, a citizen of the United States, do hereby declare
and publish as a legal notice to all the world, that I claim, and have a valid right in
the occupation, possession and enjoyment of all and singular, that tract or parcel of land
lying and being in the County of Multnomah in the State of Washington for the exclusive
right of way for the purpose of constructing a flume or water ditch from the
Columbia River on the north bank of said stream to a point on said stream more
particularly described as follows: Commencing at a point on the North bank of said
River about seven hundred and fifty (750) feet above Upper Cascade Rapids
and running thence down stream along the North bank of said River ten thousand
(10,000) feet, more or less. I also claim, and have a valid right to the
enjoyment and use of ten thousand cubic feet per second of force of water
from said stream for power and manufacturing purposes, to be conveyed
through such flume or water ditch to said point on said stream above mentioned
together with all and singular, the hereditaments and appurtenances thereto
belonging or in anywise appertaining.
