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Notice of Appropriation of Water.

Notice is hereby given that H. A. Hostetler of Portland, County of Multnomah State of Oregon hereby appropriates Five cubic feet per second of time of the water of Dry Creek, to be diverted from the right bank of said stream at a point which bears 500 feet East & 1000 feet North from a point where said creek crosses the North line of Section 36 Township four North Range Nine East W. M., by means of a dam five feet high & ditch or flume which ditch or flume extends in a southerly direction from said point of diversion and will be constructed Two feet wide at the bottom, three feet wide at the water surface and to carry one foot depth of water, with a grade of two feet per thousand. The name of the said proposed ditch or canal is Hostetler's Ditch or flume, the owner thereof being H. A. Hostetler, his associates successors and assigns, of the County of Multnomah, State of Oregon, and the waters hereby appropriated are to be used for domestic, irrigation & fluming. If for irrigation purposes, the water will be used on land in and joining Section 36 Tps. four North Range Nine E. W. M.
