

Notice of Water Right

Notice is hereby given that I, the undersigned, hereby claim the water in a certain branch, or fork of Rock Creek, sometimes known as Juan Creek, running through the South half of the Southeast quarter of Section thirty-five, Township three North of Range seven East of Willamette Meridian in Stevens County, State of Washington, to the extent of three cubic feet per second of time. Said water to be diverted at or near a small mill frame on said creek near the Southeast corner of said property and conveyed by means of flumes, pipes or ditches for floating timber, irrigation or domestic purposes.
