that the above named petitioner has commenced an action against the above named claimant in the above entitled court and cause for the condemnation and appropriation of a tract of land in Skamania County, Washington, described as follows, to-wit:

Beginning at a point on the northerly right of way line of petitioner in lot one, section twenty-nine, township three north of range eight east of the Willamette Meridian, said point being 50 feet distant from and at right angles to Station No. 1517+35 of the railway survey of said Railway Company, thence in a northerly direction at right angles to said Station No. 1517+35 a distance of 100 feet from said point, thence in a westerly direction parallel with and 100 feet northerly of said right of way line a distance of 64 feet, more or less, to the center of a wagon road, the center line of said wagon road being the division line of the property of B. L. Shurtleff and Roland D. Gould, thence southerly along the center of said wagon road a distance of 104 feet, more or less, to a point on the said northerly line of railroad right of way, and thence easterly along said northerly line of right of way 93 feet, more or less, to the place of beginning, and containing 18-100 acres of land, more or less.

That the object of said petition is to condemn said tract of land and to appropriate the whole thereof for the purpose of obtaining materials for construction and for excavations and embankments to enable the petitioner to construct and prepare its road and roadbed for its line of railroad.
