Notice is hereby given that the undersigned, desiring to avail himself of the rights and privileges provided by law for the appropriation of water, does hereby appropriate the water being and flowing in and from Hamilton Creek, in the County of Skamania, State of Washington, to the extent of 20 cubic feet per second of time, which claim the undersigned makes for himself, his heirs, executors, administrators and assigns.

The water hereby appropriated to be taken and diverted at or near the point where this notice is posted, to-wit: At or near a point about 250 feet South of the point where the Sectional line between Sections Six (6) and Seven (7) in Township Two (2) North of Range Seven back of the Willamette Meridian, intersects the said Hamilton Creek in said County of Skamania, State of Washington. The water to be taken from said place of diversion by means of a dam, flumes, pipes and ditches as may be convenient or necessary. The water so converted to be used for manufacturing power, water-supply, domestic and irrigation purposes in Section Sixteen (16) and in such other sections as may be desired, in Township Two (2) North of Range Seven back of the Willamette Meridian.

the point where this notice is posted, to-wit: at or near the point where ranges Six (6) and Seven (7) back of the Willamette Meridian cross the said Hamilton Creek on the West line of Section Six (6) in Township Two (2) North of Range Seven back of the Willamette Meridian about 520 feet South of the quarter corner on the West line of said Section Six (6) Township Two (2) North of Range Seven back. The water to be taken from said place of diversion by means of a dam, flumes, pipes or ditches as may be convenient or necessary. The water so converted to be used for manufacturing power, water-supply domestic and irrigation purposes in Section Sixteen, and in such other sections as may be desired in said Township Two (2) North of Range Seven back of the Willamette Meridian.
